

## Bills of Interest that Did Not Pass

# Lobbyist Registration

- Working with Office of Counsel and District Clerk to Implement the new requirements
- Legislation requires:
  - Develop a lobbyist registration process
  - Post a database to the District website of registered lobbyists/principals
  - Be diligent to ascertain whether persons required to register have complied
  - Not knowingly authorize a person who is not registered to lobby the District
