## Significant Legislation that Passed

- **SB 1986 - Water Management Districts**
- **HB 377 - Miami-Dade County Lake Belt Mitigation Plan**
- **HB 1389 - Water Storage and Water Quality Improvements**
- **SB 924 - Everglades *Day* – *SB924***



## Bills of Interest that Passed

- **HB 7003 - Environmental Resource Permitting**
- **HB 7051 - Numeric Nutrient Criteria**
- **HB 503 - Environmental Regulation**

## Budget (Pending Governor's Approval)

### FY 2011-12 General Appropriations Act

- **\$30,000,000 - Everglades Restoration**
- **\$4,400,000 - Everglades (Alligator Alley Tolls; FDOT to SFWMD)**
- **\$5,000,000 - Northern Everglades Wetland Hybrid Treatment (DACCS)**
- **\$15,863,535 - WMLTF (includes \$6.9M payment for debt service and aid to Suwannee River Water Management District)**



## Budget (Pending Governor's Approval)

- **\$7,892,250 - TMDL's**
- **\$5,000,000 - Statewide Numeric Nutrient Criteria Monitoring Network**
- **\$50,000,000 - Florida Keys Wastewater**
- **\$8,700,000 - Florida Forever Funding**
- **\$4,000,000 - Flood Mitigation**
