

Reduction of Costs and Creation of Efficiencies Regarding Environmental Resource Permitting Rules

Governing Board Meeting
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Overview

- Two goals of Executive Order 11-211 are to reduce the regulatory burden on the citizens of Florida and determine whether existing rules are duplicative or unnecessarily burdensome
- In furtherance of these goals, the District has reviewed its rules and identified the following amendments:
 - Reduce the number of copies applicants are required to submit from 5 to 1;
 - Increase duration of conceptual permits from 2 years to 5;
 - Repeal definitions and exemptions duplicative of Florida Statutes.

Recommended Action

- A. Request Office of Fiscal Accountability and Regulatory Reform review in accordance with Section 2, Executive Order 11-211;
- B. Authorize publication of Notice of Rule Development in Florida Administrative Weekly (FAW);
- C. Authorize publication of Notice of Proposed Rule in FAW if no workshops are requested and there are no changes to rule text as published in Notice of Rule Development; and
- D. Adopt proposed rules 28 days after publication of Notice of Proposed Rule provided no changes are made to proposed rule as published.
