





Spanish Creek Area Restoration Fiscal Contribution

- ❖ Engineering – Hydrological Studies – **ERP** (Lee County \$350K)
- ❖ Physical Restoration Spanish Creek (DEP Grant \$150K)
- ❖ Design – Periphyton/Algal Research cells, Construction Water Resources Storage, STA & Habitat (\$200,000 Matching Grant w/SFWMD)

Lee County Natural Resources Committed to Spanish Creek and County-line 4 Corners Flow-way design, implementation from three sources noted.... \$650,000 +/- to project planning and initial construction. They will also support start-up management until project is stabilized.

- Needed information for ERP on County-line Flow-way and Spanish Creek Design
- Collaborative Solution: SFWMD, Lee County, Hendry County and State of Florida Babcock State Preserve
- A Cornerstone of a C-43 Water Storage “Back-up” Strategy of Distributed Storage & Water Quality – “A Dirt Turning Credibility Project in the Caloosahatchee”
- Cost: Less than \$8 million for the District (any match funding will improve Lee County’s incentive to move forward)
