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Governor's Executive Order 11-01

- **Established Office of Fiscal Accountability and Regulatory Reform (OFARR) to review all rules before promulgation**
- **Required 90-day review of existing rules and regulations to determine whether any are duplicative or unnecessarily burdensome**
- **Established April 4 deadline to complete rule review and submit recommendations to Office of Fiscal Accountability and Regulatory Reform**

Governor's Executive Order 11-72



- **Continue Office of Fiscal Accountability and Regulatory Reform (OFARR) review all rules before promulgation**
- **Submit to OFARR an annual regulatory plan**
 - **Identify and describe each rule that we anticipate initiating rule development over the next 12 months**

Recommended 2011 Regulatory Plan

- **Ongoing Rulemaking**
 - 4 rules
- **Repeal**
 - 58 rules
- **Amendment**
 - 75 rules
- **Propose new rules to reduce costs, reflect statutory change, or update and clarify rules**
 - **Consumptive Use Permits**
 - **Environmental Resource Permits**
 - **Works of the District**



Next Step

- **Prior to going forward with rule development, staff will seek governing board approval to submit rule for review by OFARR (Executive Order 11-72)**

Section 1. I hereby direct all agencies under the direction of the Governor, prior to developing new rules or amending or repealing existing rules, to submit all proposed notices, along with the complete text of any proposed rule or amendment, to OFARR. These agencies shall also submit any other documentation required by OFARR, and no such agency may submit for publication any required notice without OFARR's approval.
