

Big Cypress Basin Field Station



■ Location –

- New site is within the City Gate Commerce Center.
- Located out of the storm surge path.
- Closer to 70% of canals and water control structures.
- Centrally located within BCB's Service Area.
- Provides strategic area for after-storm responses.

Solicitation Summary

Step 1 - Qualifications (Package 1) evaluation to short-list Respondents.

- 8 firms submitted Statements of Qualifications
- Short-List established on September 3, 2013
 - CDM Constructors, Inc.
 - DeAngelis Diamond Construction, Inc.
 - Manhattan Construction (Florida), Inc.
 - O-A-K/Florida, Inc.
 - Wright Construction Group, Inc.

Solicitation Summary

Step 2 - Project Approach (Package 2) evaluation and Interviews.

- Scores previously determined in Step 1 were combined with the scores from Step 2 for a total response score.

Resolution

A Resolution of the Governing Board of the South Florida Water Management District to authorize the official ranking of short-listed firms and entering into a 1-year contract, subject to successful negotiations with **DeAngelis Diamond Construction, Inc.** for 70% design and stipulated price proposal of the Big Cypress Basin Field Station Relocation, in an amount not-to-exceed \$1,000,000.00 of which ad valorem funds are budgeted in FY14. If negotiations are unsuccessful with DeAngelis Diamond Construction, INC., the District will proceed with negotiations in ranked order until a contract has been successfully negotiated; providing an effective date.
