Re: Public Records Act Request

Dear Ms. Kramer:

On behalf of the Miccosukee Tribe of Indians of Florida ("Tribe"), I hereby request, pursuant to Chapter 119 of the Florida Statutes, that the South Florida Water Management District ("SFWMD") make available immediately, but no later than July 7, 2009, for inspection and copying, the below identified public records. The term public records includes, but is not limited to, all documents, papers, letters, maps, books, tapes, photographs, films, sound recordings, data processing software, or other material, regardless of the physical form, characteristics, or means of transmission, including without limitation e-mails and records of oral communications.

The "C-139 citrus grove" is defined to mean that citrus grove located in the C-139 basin that is to be acquired by the South Florida Water Management District from the U.S. Sugar Corporation with the initial 72,500 acres in the River of Grass acquisition.

- Any and all documents showing or describing man-made features on the C-139 citrus grove;
- Any and all documents showing or describing features that would permit, at this time, the C-139 citrus grove to be used as a storage reservoir;
- Any and all plans for future use by the District of the C-139 citrus grove;
- Any and all due diligence materials in the South Florida Water Management District's possession or control concerning the C-139 citrus grove;
- Any and all documents that show the types and levels of pollutants on the C-139 citrus grove lands;

- Any and all documents showing or describing features that would permit, at this time, the C-139 citrus grove to be used for water quality treatment;
- Any and all documents that show any plans by the SFWMD to divert excess volumes of water from the C-139 citrus grove lands into STA 5/6 for treatment, and the volume of water that will be delivered to STA 5/6.

We request that you provide us with information with regard to anticipated costs as soon as possible and prior to production or reproduction. We ask that the documents that we have requested be provided to us in an electronic format (or the web address be provided) to help facilitate the release of this public information, as envisioned under the Public Records Act.
