
On behalf of the Miccosukee Tribe of Indians of Florida ("Tribe"), I hereby request, pursuant to Chapter 119 of the Florida Statutes, that the South Florida Water Management District ("SFWMD") make available for inspection and copying, the below identified public records. The term public records includes, but is not limited to, all documents, papers, letters, maps, books, tapes, photographs, films, sound recordings, data processing software, or other material, regardless of the physical form, characteristics, or means of transmission, including without limitation e-mails and records of oral communications.

The Tribe seeks public records regarding the deposition of Executive Director Carol Wehle on July 7, 2009. The specific documents the Tribe seeks in relation to that deposition are:

Any presentation, Power Point or otherwise, that Executive Carol Wehle, or any member of the SFWMD staff, made to the Governing Board of the South Florida Water Management District concerning the estimated costs of building infrastructure projects and facilities on the lands to be acquired from U.S. Sugar Corporation at any time prior to the Governing Board's December 16, 2008 vote or at any time prior to the Governing Board's May 13, 2009 votes to acquire such property.

The Tribe requests that the documents, or web site reference for such documents if they exist, be provided expeditiously, as the hearing on this matter occurs next week.
